Puzzle Medical is developing a percutaneous heart pump for patients with advanced heart failure. The device's modular design allows for safe percutaneous implantation to support both renal and cardiac function through 4mm-pumps anchored in parallel in the descending aorta, allowing stability for patient mobility, mechanical hemodynamic support, helping patients with increased accessibility, improved quality of life, and reduced hospitalizations. To date, Puzzle Medical has successfully: completed a Seed financing round (2022); completed a Series A financing round (2023); completed its first-in-human study with all patients experiencing improvements in cardiac and kidney function (2022); received U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Breakthrough Device Designation (2021).
